1. Get up with(THANKSGIVING) Jesus said, " Your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Matt 6:8-9
2. Bless God's name at(PRAISE)  "Hallowed be your name" Matthew 6:9b  "Every day I will bless your name, and praise it forever and ever!" Psalm 145:
3. At midmorning, what matters most.  (DEDICATION)  "May your kingdom come, and may your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." Matthew 6:10
4. List my at lunch. (PETITION)  "Give us today our daily bread." Matthew 6:11  "Jesus has the power of God, by which he gives us everything we need to live, and to serve God. We have these things because we know him." 2 Peter 1:3
5. Ask for in the afternoon. (CONFESSION)  "Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us." Matthew 6:12  "I confessed my sins to you and didn't try to hide them  Then you forgave me and now all my guilt is gone!" Psalm 32:5
6. Ask God to help me make decisions.  (PROTECTION)  "And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one." When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you will not give into it.  1 Corinthians 10:13
